East West Rail and YOU?

Meeting at 6-8pm on January 14th 2024 - Harston Village Hall.

Come and get an independent update on how the East West Rail Southern route through Harston and Hauxton might impact residents. The meeting, independent of EWR, will update residents on the plan to run a railway route along the South and Eastern edges of Harston and along the Eastern boundary of Hauxton. Please come to this

What you will hear at the meeting:

1. The **impact** of the Southern route on road travel in the Harston/Hauxton area, including intended road closures and their impact on our communities and our facilities – as well as **environmental and pollution impacts on residents. This is a 120 year project according to DfT.**
2. What will happen over the next 12 months, when the Development Consent Order will be granted to EWR, to allow detailed planning and costing of the routes, and the subsequent Inspector led independent Public Enquiry which allows those affected in Harston and Hauxton to formally register their views and possibly influence the final decision.
3. A discussion of the political and financial landscape, with contributions from
 - a. **Chris Carter-Chapman - Conservative**
 - b. **Pippa Heyling - Lib-Dem South Cambs**
 - c. **William Harrold - Cambridge Approaches**
 - d. As well as input from leading local parishioners.And following the election in 2024 will the EWR project still be funded?
4. What we should do to protect the future of our villages.
